Sat Nov 7th: West Street Trail - 1:30pm-3:30pm

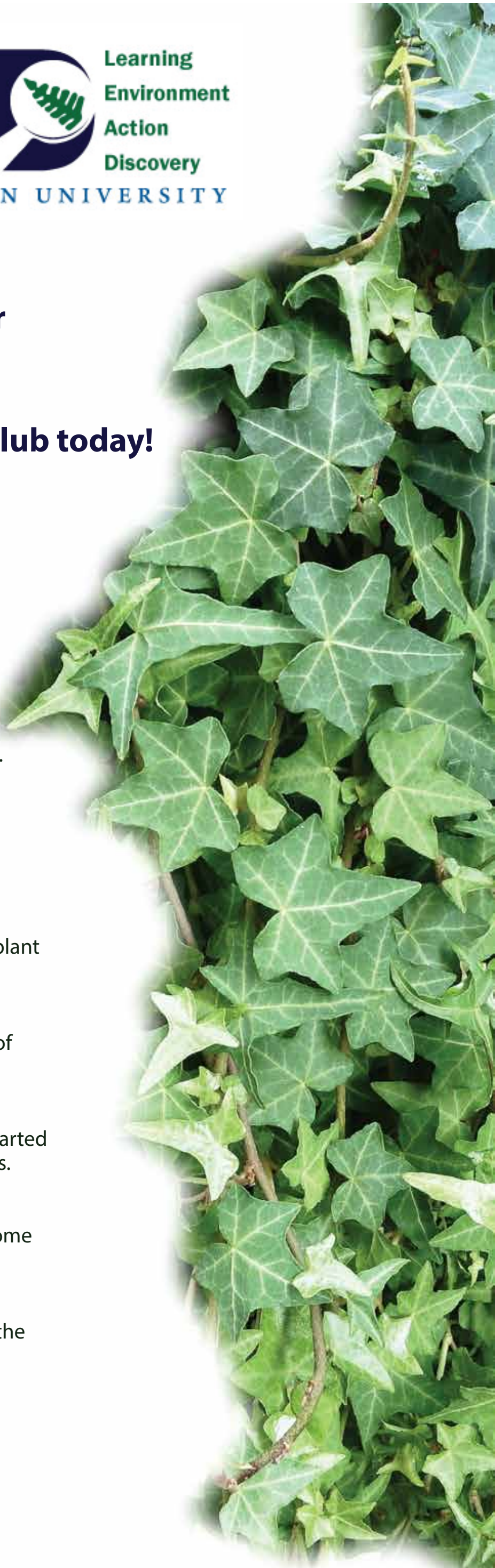
Remove weeds and spread mulch along this little stretch of trail in the Columbia Neighborhood.
